Sa darating na Hunyo 19, 2021 ay ipagdiriwang ang ika-160 taon ng kapanganakan ng natatanging yaman ng Calamba at pambansang bayani na si Dr. Jose Rizal. Kasabay nito ay ang pag-alala sa ika-labinlimang anibersaryo ng insureksyon ng Dalubhasaan ng Lungsod ng Calamba-- ang katuwang ng lokal na pamahalaan sa pagbibigay ng kalidad na edukasyong pangkolehiyo sa mga kabataang Calambenyo.

Noong Hunyo 19, 2006, sa pangunguna ng noon ay Punong Alkalde ng Calamba na si Kgg. Joaquin M. Chipeco, Jr., ng kanyang anak na si Kgg. Justin Marc SB. Chipeco, at ng ngayon ay Pangulo ng Kolehiyo na si Dr. Leonardo F. Oplencia, ay opisyal na binuksan ang dating munisipyo bilang isang institusyong pang-edukasyon. Sa pamamagitan ng adhikaing ito, libu-libong mga mag-aaral ang nagkaroon at patuloy na nanginginabang sa oportunidad na makapagtapos ng pag-aaral sa kabila ng mga hamong pinansyal.

Bilang pagbibigay-pugay sa ika-15 taon ng Dalubhasaan, halos dalawang buwang virtual anniversary celebration ang handog ng institusyon na may temang "CCC Crystal Year: Labinlimang Taon ng Pagbibigay-kinang sa Pag-asa ng Bayan." Ang pagdiriwang na ito ay

# On Its 70th Year... A Legacy of Timeless Reverence

With the nation celebrating the 160th Birth Anniversary of Dr. Jose Rizal on June 19, 2021, the memory of that most poignant moment 10 years ago when the tallest Rizal monument was unveiled at The Plaza as the Calambeños' tribute to our greatest townmate comes back to mind. Let me share the story.

## THE STORY

What would I give someone who already has everything as he celebrates a milestone birthday?

What will be a fitting tribute to a great man who sacrificed all for his country – a man who is not only revered in his hometown but in different places around the globe?

It actually started as a dream as we were preparing for the celebration of Dr. Jose Rizal's 150th birth anniversary in 2011.

Several monthly activities were lined up for the yearlong celebration, all in commemoration of the hero's venerable life and remarkable works but there seemed to be something missing. I envisioned something more tangible, something befitting Rizal's stature as our national Hero and last Renaissance man to walk this earth. It should be something that our future generations would see as a testament of their elders' reverence to our greatest contribution to Philippine history.

These thoughts kept playing over and over in my head, caused some sleepless nights and led me to ask the opinion of several trusted friends. Then seemingly out of nowhere, like an unexpected bolt of lightning, it came . . . . . why not build a monument of Rizal and make it the tallest in the world.

## THE CONSTRUCTION

With barely three months before the targeted unveiling date of June 19, Sculptor Jonas Roces began work on the 16.4 ft. monument. In the middle of March, I thought all our plans were going to be naught when I heard that the Nueva Viscaya monument topped ours by at least 2 ½ feet. Undeterred, I challenged the Executive Committee to increase the new monument's height to 22 feet. The conference room's wall shook to the resounding chorus "YES!" The additional height also meant additional cost, leading me to approach close friends and associates who thankfully did not hesitate to contribute to the construction.

To ensure the correctness of the statue's features and its strict conformity to the guidelines on statues and monuments set by the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), I requested NHCP Executive Director Ludovico Baduy to assist us in monitoring the statue's construction. With Arch. Reynaldo Lita of NHCP and the executive committee in tow, we visited Roces in his Marikina workshop to check the progress of the statue. Comments and suggestion flew from all sides as we debated and brainstormed on how close the statue's features were to the famous portrait of the hero. Even his clothes and shoes did not escape the scrutiny of Arch. Lita and the committee members as we wanted the statue to be close as possible to real Jose Rizal's likeness.

## THE UNVEILLING OF A NEW TOURIST ATTRACTION

Exactly one and half months before June 19, Roces delivered the 22 ft. statue and placed it on its pedestal in a newly acquired 6.7 hectare property in front of our City Hall. The granite pedestal added 7.87 feet to the total height of the monument while the 15 step circular base added another 13.12 feet, bringing the monument's total height to an imposing 43 feet with an approximate weight of 2 tons.

June 19 dawned with the soft drizzle of rain. This was the day I have anticipated, the day in which I will lead the entire city in honoring our most important contribution to Philippine history. With a hush of anticipation and to the soft strain of Calamba hymn, then President Benigno S. Aquino III tugged at the ropes which parted the green curtains and unveiled our humble tribute to our greatest kababayan. The new Rizal monument became the newest tourist and historical landmark not only in the city but in the entire country. It may very well be the pilgrimage site for people around the globe who have been inspired and enlightened by our hero's ideals and writings.



## THE GIFT

I now gaze upon Dr. Rizal's new statue with serene and contemplative expression seemingly looking out for the City and I remember his admonition to us all through the character of Elias in his novel, *Noli Me Tangere*, "I die without seeing the dawn brighten over my native land. You who have it to see, welcome it and forget not those who have fallen during the night". The monument that we envisioned and built is not in itself our greatest achievement and contribution. The greatest accomplishment that I pray we have achieved is the continued enlightenment of our countrymen through the life and works of the hero that we paid homage to, the hero who yearned to see the dawn of freedom and had fallen in the night. The greatness of his monument is equaled only by the depth of each Calambeños' commitment to perpetuate the legacy of our greatest kababayan . . . for the whole world to see and future generations to treasure.

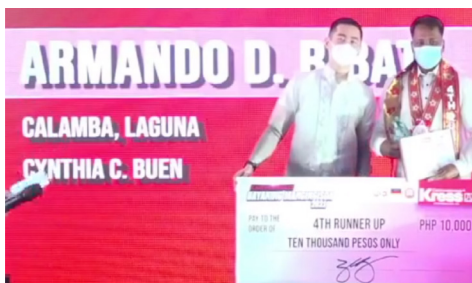
## CALAMBEÑO NAHIRANG NA BAYANING MANGINGISDA, 4TH Runner Up

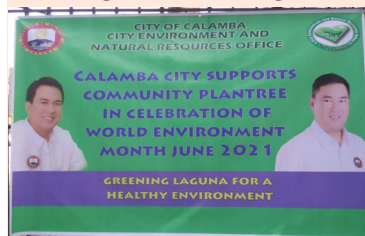

The **Safety Seal Certification** is a voluntary certification scheme that affirms that an establishment is compliant with the minimum public health standards set by the government and uses or integrates its contact tracing with StaySafe.ph.

**VALIDITY:**

Valid for 6 months upon issuance, except for those issued to tourism enterprises which shall be valid for one (1) year; renewable

**CERTIFICATION PROCESS**

(FOR ESTABLISHMENTS TO APPLY UNDER THE LGU)

**STEP 1**

Submit application and applicable requirements online via Google Forms. (<http://bit.ly/safetyseal-CALAMBA>)

**STEP 2**

Validation of submitted requirements and site inspection

**STEP 3**

Once approved, wait for Safety Seal Certification sent via EMAIL

**SAFETY SEAL CERTIFICATION CHECKLIST**

- Use of StaySafe.ph or any contact tracing tool integrated with the StaySafe.ph app.
- Availability of temperature/thermal scanner
- Availability of health declaration sheet for employees and clients
